



Futsal Rules

Kick Off	Ball must be played back to start play.
Penalty Kick	Free throw line is where the penalty will be taken. Free throw box is where a penalty can be called. Anything outside of it, is a free kick. Everyone but the player and goalie must be behind the 3pt line.
Duration of Match	20 minute halves & 2 minute half time. Time can only be stopped during a time out. Any other plays, time will continue to play on.
Ball Size	Division: 2009-2012 Size 4 Division: 2013-2015 Size 3
Time out Per Half	1 timeout per half allowed (1 minute in duration)
Restarts	Only 4 seconds on all kickoffs, corner kicks, goal clearance and free kicks. Ball must completely stop before it can be live. Goal kick: ball must start from yellow line for every restart Free kick: Players can score directly into goal from a free kick. Kick in: Player must pass to teammate, shooting directly into goal is not allowed unless a teammate touches the ball. A kick-in that goes into the goal will result in a goal kick for the opposing team. Corner kick: Players can score directly from corner kick.
Speed of Play	Enhance speed of play by playing quick and avoid long restarts for every foul or out of bounds.
Goalkeeper	Goalie is able to score when play is live but can not drop kick it into goal or score from a throw.

Headers	Headers are allowed across all divisions.
Out of Bounds	Ball is still in even if it's touching the line. Ball must be completely out of bounds.
Fouls	<p>Referees must call unsportsmanship fouls, foul language, tripping, shoving. Etc. Responsible for keeping the game in control and giving advantage to the attacking team if play is building forward.</p> <p>Yellow Card: Book after 1-2 verbal warnings and make a decision based on how the foul was.</p> <p>Red Card: Intention to hurt a player or excessive aggression</p>
Free Kicks	<p>Every foul on the field will be a free kick except if it's in the penalty box area. Penalty given will be given on the free throw line.</p> <p>Wall must be 4 feet separated from the kicker, normal steps.</p> <p>Only indirect kick if a player makes a foul by not allowing the play to develop or using foul language.</p>
Referee	Referees will be in charge of writing down scores into notepad.
Scorekeepers	Responsible for keeping track of score/update on TeamSnap per game. Scores will be updated to TeamSnap within 30 min of game completion.
Parents	Invcitus won't tolerate any foul language or any misconduct. If the parent is not cooperating give them a warning but if it continues please remove the parent out of the center.
Attire	Players are only allowed to play with indoor shoes. Players are prohibited from playing in cleats.
Substitutions	All substitutions are on the fly, this includes goalkeeping substitutions. A substitute may not enter the pitch until the player leaving the pitch leaves through the substitution zone in front of his teams' bench. Any substitute who enters the pitch before the player being replaced has completely left the field of play may be shown a yellow card.
Group Play	<p>Scoring:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Win = 3 points - Tie = 1 point - Loss = 0 points <p>Tiebreaker: In the event of a tie, the following criteria shall apply</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Total points 2. Head to head competition (does not apply in a 3 or more way tie) 3. Largest goal differential

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">4. Most goals scored5. Fewest goals allowed6. Penalty kicks
Playoffs	<p>If the game is a draw, both teams will advance to a penalty shoot out. The team that wins the best of 5 penalties will win the game. If the game is still drawn after penalties, the penalties will go into 'sudden death'. No single player can take more than one penalty, unless every team member has taken a penalty.</p>
